## Clear Round Cross Poles 9:00 – 9:30am - £3 per round or 2 for £5 Rosettes to all clear rounds

### Jumping classes start 9:30am

| Class 1 | Poles on the floor – Rosette to all competitors (no timed section)   |
|---------|--|
| Class 2 | First Hole Cross Poles – Lead rein   |
| Class 3 | First Hole Cross Poles – Off the lead rein   |
| Class 4 | Cross poles Horse and Groom – groom jumps all jumps on foot then the horse and rider fastest combination wins. |
| Class 5 | Straight Poles approx. 20/30cm   |
| Class 6 | Cross Poles approx. 30/40cm  |
| Class 7 | Pairs Jumping cross poles 30/40cm fastest combination wins.  |

### Clear Round 40cm - £3 per round or 2 for £5

| Class 8  | Beginners Jumping 40cm |
|----------|------------------------|
| Class 9  | Cross Poles 50cm       |
| Class 10 | Beginners Jumping 50cm |
| Class 11 | Novice 60cm            |

## PLEASE REMEMBER THIS IS A FUNJUMPING SHOW NOT FOR THOSE HORSES WHO COMPETE COMPETIVELY.

#### **Rules on the Day**

- \*No eliminations for a refusal this is a fun jumping show. Each pole down results in 4 faults and each refusal results in 4 faults.
- \*Optional to jump the first round to get used to the course and then re jump the course timed to secure your placing. (with the exception of poles on the ground, horse and groom and pairs jumping these will have one round for each rider).
- \*Optional for all classes to be lead or have someone run alongside.
- \*Welcome to stand in the ring and assist if required.
- \*Placing rosette 1<sup>st</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> and special to all other competitors. Each class will award rosettes/ placings separately for those 12yrs and under and 13yrs +

#### **General Show Rules**

- 1. The judges decision is final. The organiser also reserves the right to substitute a judge should it be necessary.
- 2. Please do not muck out on the showground. Hay to be kept in lorry/trailer and all rubbish to be taken home or placed in bins provided.
- 3. Animals are NOT to be tied to the side of vehicles/trailors/ lorries etc and left unattended. If leaving your animal please place them back in you transport vehicle with the ramp up, due to main gates being open to prevent animals escaping/ getting lose.
- 4. Please follow any parking signs/directions from officials
- 5. Objections must be lodged in writing to the show secretary within 30 minutes of the class ending along with a £20 fee. This fee will be refunded if the objection is upheld.
- 6. Unacceptable behaviour from competitors/ owners/ spectators will not be tolerated by the show officials. All competitors/ owner/ spectators should follow instructions from officials. Unacceptable behaviour could result in you being asked to leave the showground and the possibility of being banned from future events.
- 7. Current standard riding hats must be worn at all times while mounted on the showground and also by children 16 years and under in the ring.
- 8. All horse/ponies ridden must be 4 years old or over.
- 9. Passports must be produced upon request.
- 10. The Equestrian Box Events and the event venue, nor any of its officers, servants or assistants shall in any way be responsible or accountable for any loss, injury or damage to any person, animal, vehicle or property in connection with or arising from this show. It is a condition of entry that all exhibitors or their servants shall indemnify the Equestrian Box Events, its officials, servants or assistants against all action, proceedings, claims or otherwise in relation to or arising from his/her entries in the show. All exhibitors should ensure that they have sufficient third-party/public liability insurance. Each entry form must be signed as having accepted these conditions by a person over the age of 18. By entering online, we accept this as you signing to confirm agreement to the above.
- 11. Refunds/ credits will not be issued for any classes/events that you are unable to take part in after payment has been made.
